Recipe from the Welcome Back Breakfast & Service –

Breakfast Bake (Sylvia G.)

Ingredients

- 1 pound bacon, diced or can use sausage
- 1 medium sweet onion, chopped
- 9 large eggs, lightly beaten
- 4 cups frozen shredded hash brown potatoes, thawed
- 2 cups cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1 1/2 cups small curd cottage cheese
- 1 1/4 cups Swiss cheese, shredded

Directions

- Step 1 -Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F.
- Step 2 -Grease a 9x13-inch baking dish.
- Step 3 -Heat a large skillet over medium-high heat.
- Step 4 -Add the bacon (or sausage) and the onion to the skillet and cook, stirring regularly, until the bacon is evenly browned, about 10 minutes.
- Step 5 -Drain the excess liquid from the skillet.
- Step 6 -In a large bowl, add the bacon (or sausage) mixture, the eggs, the hash brown potatoes, the cheddar cheese, the cottage cheese, and the Swiss cheese and stir to combine.
- Step 7 -Pour the bacon mixture into the prepared baking dish.
- Step 8 -Bake the casserole until the eggs are set and the cheese is melted, about 45-50 minutes.
- Step 9 -Allow the casserole to stand for 10 minutes before cutting and serving.
- Step 10 -Serve.
