The board met Friday, March 6<sup>th</sup>:

- Per the treasurer, internet and electricity costs have increased.
- The endowment did great for the month of February, but increased volatility is expected with the war in Iran.
- For the Building and Grounds report, gutters near the dining hall have come down. Plans need to be made to replace them. The health inspector inspected the kitchen. We had 2 minor violations that were easily addressed. Silver in the kitchen needs to be polished. We may bring up the possibility of asking for volunteers during one or more potluck services.
- Possible changes/additions to next year's tentative budget were discussed as well as beginning plans for the congregational meeting in April.
- Sexual Assault Awareness Month is in April. Once again Restore will be putting out the display at the church.
